10/076	<b>Wonersh Parish website</b> Clerk and Cllr Grant to work together to secure new software to permit real-time updates to the Council's website by the Clerk and Members. Clerk has received an updated quotation of £187 (ex VAT) to purchase an <i>Adobe Contribute CS5</i> package. This will be included on the February 2012 agenda.
10/169(f)	<b>Replacement of the notice board at Blackheath</b> Clerk to liaise with the Chairman of Blackheath Village Hall Committee about the installation of the proposed new community notice board.
11/085	<b>Section 9 land</b> The Clerk received the revised application form from Hedleys Solicitors to make to the HM Land Registry on 9 January 2012. This issue will now be included on the February 2012 agenda.
11/121	<b>Surrey Highways - repair to speed limit signage</b> Clerk has requested that Surrey Highways reinstate 30 mph repeater between Wonersh and Bramley.
11/161	<b>Wonersh closed burial ground</b> 1. Clerk has received a number of competitive, commercial quotations for an annual contract for the "decent" maintenance of the grounds and awaits a bid from the present contractors. 2. Clerk has received one bid so far for a professional survey for the walls enclosing the burial ground and is seeking others. These issues will be included as a substantive item on the March 2012 agenda.

11/162(c)	<b>Drainage under Wonersh Common</b> Clerk to seek professional advice about requirements to complete a <i>call for tender</i> in respect of required repair works.
11/169	<b>Community policing issues</b> Pc Kerby has (a) forwarded advice/application forms about the Active Citizen System and (b) provided further background/updates on local crimes. Local road accident data/statistics held by Surrey County Council (SCC) awaited.
11/177	<b>2012 Parish Assembly</b> The Clerk has booked the Arbutnot Hall. Mr Colin Davis has accepted the Council's invitation to make a presentation about traffic-calming and de-cluttering. Surrey Highways have also been invited to attend.
11/179	<b>Community Project bids submitted to County Cllr Povey</b> The Clerk will provide an update at the meeting about resources Cllr Povey has allocated in principle to various parish projects.
11/183	<b>Commercial use of the pavement on The Street, Wonersh</b> The Clerk has informed the shopowner of legal requirements to secure permission from Waverley Borough Council (WBC) and Surrey County Council (SCC) to display items on the pavement as well as to respect the rights of pedestrians by not obstructing the path.
