11/121	Surrey Highways - repair to speed limit signage The Clerk and the Chairman have reminded Surrey Highways of its commitment to reinstate the 30 mph repeater between Wonersh and Bramley.
11/162(a)	Council Quality Status Cllr Powell-Evans to arrange a meeting of the Working Party.
11/162(c)	Drainage under Wonersh Common Cllr Bawden is seeking professional advice about requirements to complete a <i>call for tender</i> in respect of required repair works.
12/014	Amenities for older children in the parish Mr Rogers had a meeting with the Wonersh-based members of the Voluntary Playgrounds Committee on 8 February to agree on separate but complementary approaches to awareness-raising and future fund-raising for older children's amenities as well as for younger ones.
