10/169(f)	<b>Replacement of the community notice board at Blackheath</b> New noticeboard ordered from manufacturer, <i>Harry Stebbings Workshop</i> . Delivery delayed to the end of July 2012.
11/162(a)	<b>Council Quality Status</b> Cllr Powell-Evans to arrange a meeting of the Working Party.
11/162(c)	<b>Drainage under Wonersh Common</b> Cllr Bawden is seeking professional advice about requirements to complete a <i>call for tender</i> in respect of required repair works.
12/017(e)	<b>Emergency Planning</b> The Clerk is updating the Plan and will distribute the latest version to all Members in due course.
12/036	<b>Section 9 land</b> HM Land Registry has not accepted the Council's application for a caution against a parcel of land and advised that the Council should apply to register as the owner. This will now be included as an agenda item in July 2012.
12/079	<b>Protective posts for common land in Wonersh</b> The Clerk is seeking quotations for the repair of posts and the installation of new ones around Wonersh Common and the Platt.

12/099(iv)	<b>Litter and dog fouling</b> Clerk is consulting WBC about the installation of additional litter bins near litter hot spots and for signage advertising that litter bins can be used for the disposal of bagged dog mess.
12/103	<b>2011/12 Audit of Accounts – update</b> The Internal Auditor visited the Parish Office to inspect the accounts and office systems on 31 May 2012. He complimented Mr Holmes on the “model” spreadsheet system he had created for the Council. The Internal Auditor was pleased to sign Section 4 of the

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Annual Return without making any qualifications. The Annual return now goes to the External Auditor for examination.

Cllr Powell-Evans and the Clerk are satisfied that an application would not unduly fetter the Council's ability to pursue improvements at the playground, sports field and Pavilion.
