11/162(c)	<p><b>Drainage under Wonersh Common</b> Cllr Bawden is seeking professional advice about requirements to complete a <i>call for tender</i> in respect of required repair works.</p>
12/017(e)	<p><b>Emergency Planning</b> The Clerk is updating the Plan and will distribute the latest version to all Members in due course.</p>
12/036	<p><b>Section 9 land</b> HM Land Registry has not accepted the Council's application for a caution against a parcel of land and advised that the Council should apply to register as the owner. Clerk awaits recommended draft application from Hedleys Solicitors for consideration by the Council. This will now be included as an agenda item in April 2013.</p>
12/079	<p><b>Protective posts for common land in Wonersh</b> Old posts have been repaired and new ones installed on council-owned common land in Wonersh. The Clerk is liaising with Surrey Highways about positioning new posts along the grass verges along the B2128 highway close to Wonersh Village centre.</p>
12/150 (d)	<p><b>Additional community notice board in Wonersh</b> The new notice board is due to be installed in April 2013.</p>
12/105	<p><b>Application for <i>QE II Field</i> status for Wonersh Sports Ground</b> The Clerk has submitted the application. Fields in Trust will be sending a team to visit the Sports Ground.</p>

12/153	<b>Request for new bus shelter(s) at The Street, Wonersh</b> To be considered further at a future meeting of the Council.
12/192	<b>Public concern about obstructive and dangerous parking near the Pepperpot junction, Wonersh</b> The Council is due to consider this issue again at its March 2013 meeting.
12/13 231	<b>Motor vehicle parking in the centre of Shamley Green</b> Cllr Powell-Evans has an appointment to see the Head Teacher of Longacre School on 22 March and has compiled a list of Walking and Rambling organisations to who she is going to write.
12/13 232	<b>Future of Gerald's Wood</b> The Council to consider proposals for the future sustainable management of the woodland by a community volunteer group at its meeting in May 2013.
12/13 233	<b>Allotments</b> The Clerk hosted an open meeting with allotment holders and prospective allotment holders on Thursday, 7 March at 7.30pm. He will submit a report ahead of a substantive agenda item for the Council's meeting in April.
12/13 248(c)	<b>Litter and dog fouling</b> The Clerk has received signage for placing on litter bins throughout the parish showing that dog mess in plastic bags can be placed in the bins. The Clerk is seeking quotes for new bins which could be installed at litter hot spots in the parish. He will also arrange for a guided tour of local litter hotspots for Mr Paul Redmond, WBC Environmental Services.
12/13 251	<b>Proposed expansion of the Wonersh &amp; Shamley Green (Church of England) Infant School to Primary School status beginning in September 2014</b> The Clerk has submitted the Council's observations about the proposals to the school. The present public consultation period remains open until 22 March 2013.
12/13 257	<b>Buildings of Local Merit (BLM)</b> The Clerk has submitted the latest approved recommendations to WBC.
12/13 255	<b>Affordable Housing in the Parish</b> Cllr Holtom has submitted a report about the affordable housing exhibitions.
12/12 256	<b>Application for The Villagers Public House, Blackheath to be designated as an Asset of Community Value (ACV)</b> The Clerk has received an acknowledgement from WBC about the application submitted by the Blackheath Village Society and supported by the Council. WBC to make a determination by 4 April 2013.
