Contractor to install shortly</p> <p>(b) Pavement extension between Wonersh and Bramley</p> <p>The Clerk has been informed that this is unlikely to go ahead because of the prohibitive cost - £150,000. Detailed letter from SCC awaited;</p> <p>(c) Repair to highway bollards and low wall beside water spring at Lordshill Lane – Action awaited by SCC;</p> <p>(d) Shamley Green traffic-calming project: VAS at Church Hill and one red reflector still to be installed (SCC);</p> <p>(e) Stroud Lane flooding problems - Action awaited by SCC;</p> <p>(f) Guildford Road (B2128), Shamley Green, flooding problems SCC are due to clear some of the drains under the highway.
