12/13 283	<p>Surrey County Council (SCC) Highways roads and pavement repairs/improvements Projects and other works reported (outstanding):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Repair to highway bollards and low wall beside water spring at Lordshill Lane – Action awaited by SCC; (b) Stroud Lane flooding problems - Action awaited by SCC.; (c) Guildford Road (B2128), Shamley Green, flooding problems – badly flooded since Christmas day. Anti flooding measures implemented so far only partially successful. An important outstanding action by SCC is to discover the ownership of the strip of land running alongside the road at grist Hill so that responsibility for the ditch can be established. (d) Lordshill commons, ditch/drainage works – the WBC Countryside Ranger is examining the problems. (e) One of the finger posts at Stroud Lane/Woodhill Lane is broken (f) New signpost to replace broken one at junction of Stroud Lane and b2128 has yet to be installed. (g) Signpost at corner of Blackheath Lane and Wonersh Common is damaged.
