<p><b>13/14 160/221(c)</b></p>	<p><b>Replacement playground equipment Grant from the Surrey Legacy Fund for Wonersh Playground</b> Robert Hoyland, a contractor suggested by Stonescapes has met Cllr Healy at the Wonersh Playground and agreed to bring a small digger in to remove the grass from the marked areas for the table tennis tables and the basketball hoop. The spoil will be placed along the bank of the ditch; he will also level the marked areas. This work should have been done before half term but is still outstanding. Playcrete, the equipment suppliers are preparing a formal quote, required by the Surrey Legacy Fund to release the agreed funds.</p> <p><b>Lordshill playground</b> The Lordshill playground committee have received unexpected funding of £ 2000 from a local trust fund. This has meant that they are now considering both a new tower piece of equipment and a new horse springer. The majority of the funding is now in place and the shortfall should be covered by the CIL funding but this is still unconfirmed by Waverley BC. As soon as this confirmation is received the Clerk will be requested to place the order.</p>
