If this is within the budget of the grant and the funds raised by the Playground Committee it is hoped that an order can be placed.</p> <p><b>Lordshill playground</b></p> <p>Cllr Smith has contacted Mr Clive Greenland and he has reiterated his interest in carrying out playing field levelling. <b>14/15 033(a)</b>	<b>Overgrown area at the end of Barnett Lane, near the junction with the B2128</b> Clerk has sought a quotation to be presented at the November Council meeting for these works to be carried out. He is also checking to see if County Cllr Young can contribute some grant funding towards this.
<b>14/15 033(b)</b>	<b>Additional waste bins in Shamley Green</b> Cllr Band has requested WBC install new bins in the places identified by the Parish Council.
<b>14/15 033(d)</b>	<b>Wonersh Bus Shelter</b> Cllr Grant to update the Council.
<b>14/15 033(h)</b>	<b>Review of the impact/effectiveness of the Shamley Green traffic-calming initiative.</b> See substantive agenda item 14/15 100.
<b>14/15 045</b>	<b>To consider preparations and agree the next steps for the Council elections due to take place in May 2015.</b> Leaflets on becoming a parish councillor were available at the Wonersh fete in July. Notice placed in Autumn newsletter and (in lieu) in Shamley Green November parish magazine.
<b>14/15 052</b>	<b>Blackheath commons</b> Cllr Maggs was due to meet WBC Ranger and Borough Cllr Thornton and will report to the Council meeting at item 14/15 107.
<b>14/15 078</b>	<b>New contract for the decent maintenance of the closed Wonersh burial ground.</b> New YMCA contract in place. Wonersh with Blackheath PCC has formally confirmed that it will contribute half the increased cost of the new contract. NFA.
<b>14/15 079</b>	<b>Application for funfair at Shamley Green.</b> WBC has refused permission to revive a commercial funfair on The Green. NFA.
