11/162 c	<p>Drainage under Wonersh Common</p> <p>A specification of the required works has been drawn up and forwarded to a panel of 6 potential contractors with a request to submit tenders by 31 December 2014.</p> <p>.</p>
12/017e	<p>Emergency Planning</p> <p>The Clerk is updating the Plan and will distribute the latest version to all Members in due course.</p>
14/15 103	<p>Motor vehicle parking in the centre of Shamley Green</p> <p>The Council has supported WBC proposals for additional parking on the edge of the commons. WBC to continue planning process and secure capital funding.</p>
14/15 095	<p>Future presentation of the Council's Official documents for use at Council and Committee meetings.</p> <p>Cllr Holtom has circulated a proposed, revised progress report document for consideration. This will be taken at the January meeting.</p>
13/14 028	<p>Buildings of Local Merit.</p> <p>Cllr Smith has submitted potential nominations. See substantive agenda item 14/15 123</p>
13/14 160/221 (c)	<p>Replacement playground equipment</p> <p>Grant from the Surrey Legacy Fund for Wonersh Playground</p> <p>Cllr Healy has now received a final quotation from Playcrete to include the clearing and levelling of the area and a revised area for the basketball hoop. This quotation has been accepted but the contractor has not agreed a date for the work to be carried out.. The quotation has been sent to Fields in Trust to complete the paperwork required for the Surrey Legacy Fund grant.</p> <p>Lordshill playground</p> <p>New playground equipment is being installed 3-14 November. Mr Clive Greenland has submitted quotations for playing field levelling and mole eradication. See substantive agenda item 14/15 118(e) and (f).</p>

14/15 077	Shamley Green traffic calming (SCC grant) Contract placed with <i>Guildford Driveways</i> to undertake SG island improvements. Work to be carried out in November 2014.
14/15 033(a)	Overgrown area at the end of Barnett Lane, near the junction with the B2128 Clerk has sought a quotation to be presented at the November Council meeting for these works to be carried out. See substantive agenda item 14/15 118(g)
14/15 033(b)	Additional waste bins in Shamley Green Cllr Band has requested WBC install new bins in the places identified by the Parish Council. Chairman has made 2 more requests for a bin along Tangle Lane on the Downs Link and a bin for a trial period of 6 months at the car park in Blackheath
14/15 033(d)	Wonersh Bus Shelter Cllr Grant to update the Council.
14/15 045	To consider preparations and agree the next steps for the Council elections due to take place in May 2015. Leaflets on becoming a parish councillor were available at the Wonersh fete in July. Notice placed in Autumn newsletter and (in lieu) in Shamley Green November parish magazine.
14/15 052	Blackheath commons See substantive agenda item 14/15 122
14/15 099	To consider and approve the Council's submission to Waverley Borough Council (WBC) about the proposed <i>Waverley Local Plan</i>. The Clerk has sent the submission as agreed at the Parish Council meeting on 09.10.14
14/15 101	To consider and approve the Council's comments to Surrey County Council about the implementation to-date of the Shamley Green <i>traffic-calming project</i> and other related highways safety issues. SCC has acknowledged its mistake in wrongly reinstalling white lines and cats eyes at the southern end of the B2128. The cats eyes cannot be easily removed but further consultation is required with residents, the traffic calming committee and other interested parties as to the most effective outcome. 14/15 102	To consider and approve the Council's support for a proposed traffic-calming initiative by Bramley Parish Council (BPC) to extend a request for a 20mph limit along <i>Station Road, Bramley to The Street, Wonersh</i>. See Substantive agenda item 14/15 128(a)
14/15 105	Maintenance of playgrounds at Lordshill(Shamley Green) and Barnett Lane (Wonersh) The Clerk is pursuing repairs recommended in the 2014 annual inspection report.
14/15 106	To consider a request by a neighbouring property holder for a new easement for vehicular access across the Council-owned Wonersh Common and to approve the next steps. The Clerk will commission Hedleys Solicitors to act for the Council and to bring finalised proposals to the Council for the latter's consideration and approval at a future meeting.
