14/15 103	<p>Motor vehicle parking in the centre of Shamley Green</p> <p>The Council has supported WBC proposals for additional parking on the edge of the commons. WBC to continue planning process and secure capital funding.</p>
14/15 095	<p>Future presentation of the Council's Official documents for use at Council and Committee meetings.</p> <p>Cllr Holtom has circulated a proposed, revised progress report document for consideration. This will be taken at the January meeting.</p> <p>Agenda Item 14/15 144</p>
13/14 028	<p>Buildings of Local Merit.</p> <p>The buildings approved at the Parish Council meeting on 13 Nov 2014 have been forwarded to Sean Rix, Historic Buildings Officer, WBC for approval by WBC Executive Committee.</p>
13/14 160/221 (c)	<p>Replacement playground equipment</p> <p>Grant from the Surrey Legacy Fund for Wonersh Playground</p> <p>Due to a miscommunication between Playcrete and the contractors, the basketball area only has been levelled and the basketball hoop installed. They are now waiting for the ground to harden before they complete the rest of the work. Field in Trust can release half the grant in advance but we have not been asked for a deposit by Playcrete.</p> <p>Lordshill playground</p> <p>Cllr Smith to update at Parish Council meeting</p>
14/15 077	<p>Shamley Green traffic calming (SCC grant)</p> <p>The work to install sets around the tree at the car park outside the shop at Shamley Green has been carried out and Tete-a-tete daffodil bulbs have been planted.</p> <p>NFA</p>

14/15 033(a)	Overgrown area at the end of Barnett Lane, near the junction with the B2128 The laurels have been cut back and the path area looks much cleaner and tidier. NFA
14/15 033(b)	Additional waste bins in Shamley Green Cllr Band has requested WBC install new bins in the places identified by the Parish Council. Chairman has made 2 more requests for a bin along Tangle Lane on the Downs Link and a bin for a trial period of 6 months at the car park in Blackheath
14/15 033(d)	Wonersh Bus Shelter Cllr Grant to update the Council.
14/15 045	To consider preparations and agree the next steps for the Council elections due to take place in May 2015. A piece on elections and becoming a councillor is to be issued in the January newsletter.
14/15 101	To consider and approve the Council's comments to Surrey County Council about the implementation to-date of the Shamley Green <i>traffic-calming project</i> and other related highways safety issues. The Parish Council is awaiting communication from the Shamley Green Traffic Calming Committee as to how they wish to proceed regarding the reinstatement of cats' eyes and road markings on Church Hill.
14/15 102	To consider and approve the Council's support for a proposed traffic-calming initiative by Bramley Parish Council (BPC) to extend a request for a 20mph limit along <i>Station Road, Bramley to The Street, Wonersh.</i> The chair of the Parish Council is attending a meeting of Station Road Traffic Steering group in Bramley on 12 th January
14/15 105	Maintenance of playgrounds at Lordshill(Shamley Green) and Barnett Lane (Wonersh) The Clerk is pursuing repairs recommended in the 2014 annual inspection report.
14/15 106	To consider a request by a neighbouring property holder for a new easement for vehicular access across the Council-owned Wonersh Common and to approve the next steps. The Clerk will commission Hedleys Solicitors to act for the Council and to bring finalised proposals to the Council for the latter's consideration and approval at a future meeting.
14/15 118 (d)2	Trees on Wonersh Common The Clerk has written to Mr Harding and expressed the Council's thanks for his continuing work in the parish. NFA
14/15 121	To consider proposals about the future ownership and restoration of <i>The Villagers Public House</i> (a registered asset of community value at Blackheath) and to approve the next steps. Cllr Maggs to update at Parish Council meeting.
14/15 122	To consider proposals for the Council to become more engaged in the management of the commons at Blackheath and to approve the next steps. The Council is awaiting the updated Enforcement Policy from Waverley Borough Council before it can endorse the steps agreed at the last Parish Council meeting
14/15 124	To consider the Parish Council's contribution to commemorating the centenary of the First World War over 2014 – 18 and to approve the next steps. As agreed at the last meeting, the Council will wait for proposals to be brought to them by the community. Cllr Healy is acting as liaison.

14/15 126	<p>To consider the public consultation by SCC about minerals and waste plans and to approve the next steps. As agreed, Cllr R Bawden looked at this document with a view to responding but concluded that there was nothing substantive to be said about it.</p>
14/15 127	<p>To consider and approve arrangements for the recruitment of additional, temporary Council staff to provide cover for the Clerk while the latter continues to make a phased return to work. An applicant has met with the Clerk and Cllr R Bawden and will be attending the Planning Committee meeting on 08.01.15 to appraise herself of some of the tasks involved.</p>
14/15 129	<p>Members' business and correspondence for noting or including on a future agenda</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (b) The dangerous Ash tree in Gerald's Wood has been felled. NFA. (c) The Clerk and Cllr Powell-Evans have not met with a representative of the landowner of the allotments as the representatives wish to discuss matters with the Memorial Hall Committee first. (d) The Clerk is printing more leaflets regarding parking on common land to put on the cars of transgressors and all councillors will be asked to use them as necessary.
