Local Plan Part 2: Issues and Options

Local Plan Part 2: Non Strategic Policies and Sites will form the second stage of Waverley's new Local Plan. Together with Local Plan Part 1, it will replace the current Local Plan (2002). LPP2 will contain policies that direct planning application decisions. It will allocate non-strategic sites for housing, review the boundaries of our town centres and local landscape designations, and allocate sites for gypsy and traveller accommodation.

The first consultation stage of the process is the Issues and Options Consultation, which starts on Monday 12 June and will run for 6 weeks until **5pm on 24 July 2017**. This consultation stage is intended to provoke debate and discussion and to help shape the plan prior to its next stage of preparation.
