15/16 128	<p>Open meeting for <i>members of the public</i> to raise matters with the Council.</p> <p>No members of the public were in attendance.</p>
15/16 129	<p>To consider and approve the Council's role in the oversight of traffic management at Longacre School as set out in the conditions imposed by Waverley Borough Council in granting planning application WA/2015/1518.</p> <p>The Council considered the decision of Waverley Borough Council to grant planning permission in respect of this planning application, in particular the implications of planning condition numbered 5 in the planning authority's decision letter dated 4 December 2015.</p> <p>The council RESOLVED unanimously that the Clerk should write, via email, to Longacre School today to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) seek clarification on the process the school will follow in developing the updated School Travel Plan, as required by planning condition number 5;b) enquire about the schedule the school is following to implement this work, given that only one month from the date of the planning decision has been allowed for the submission, and approval by the planning authority, of the updated School Travel Plan;c) clarify whether the school is considering appointing an independent chair to take this work forward, as was discussed at the Waverley Borough Council Eastern Area Planning Committee on 2 December; andd) ask that the school share this information with the Parish Council, given the substantial local interest in this proposed development.
