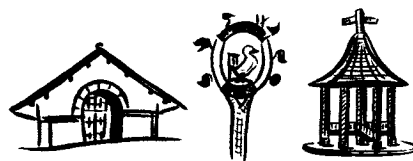

10/054 Apologies for absence were received from Cllr M Band.

10/055 Local Code of Conduct – disclosures of interests

All Councillors present declared a personal interest as Mrs B St John was known to them as a former Councillor

10/056 Open Meeting for Electors

Mrs St John requested that the Council ask Surrey County Council to provide vehicle weight restriction signs to stop large vehicles using the narrow lanes in Shamley Green particularly around the Green, Hulbrook Lane and Norley Lane. Cllr Harding explained that the location of the sewage farm, for example, meant that Thames Water vehicles had to use the access route. Similarly, over-sized school buses turned at the Green to pick-up and set-down children away from the main road. Cllr Bawden suggested contacting Thames Water to propose they contributed to a local project to off-set the damage and disturbance they caused locally. Mrs St John also raised the problem of large farm vehicles carrying slurry and to damage caused by an HGV to a bridge over a stream. Cllr Harding clarified that this was not a bridge but a conduit exit. Cllr Morris reminded members that the LORD (Lorries Off Rural Detours) had been very successful in campaigning in the county and nationally for satnav maps to display suitable routes for HGV vehicles and that SCC were unlikely to display an HGV sign because of efforts to reduce the amount of signage in the AONB.

10/057 Co-option of Parish Councillor for Shamley Green Ward

1) The chairman's reminded members that candidates had been asked to submit a written statement in support of their application (already circulated) and had been invited to give a short presentation at this meeting.

2) Presentation by Mrs B St John.

This was followed by questions from Councillors.

10/058 Chairman's resolution "That in view of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted under this item, it is advisable in the public interest that the press and public be excluded" was agreed

(Members of the public left the meeting room)

Co-option of Shamley Green Ward Parish Councillor

The chairman informed Mrs St John that Councillors had agreed she should be co-opted as a Parish Councillor. They had also agreed that she will need to undertake new Councillor and the 'Power of Well-being' training. The chairman informed Mrs St John that he would be writing to her making clear that she must ensure that as a Councillor she did not make direct contact with external agencies such as Waverley Borough Council and Surrey County Council but always to first contact the Parish Clerk.
