Matters Arising Update for Wonersh Parish Council Meeting on Thursday 12th April 2007

69. Millenium Clock,Blackheath – still pending
135. Wonersh to Shamley Green footpath - pending information from Mrs St. John
- 06/85 Lease at Lordshill Playground – Clerk has written to Ailsa Rhodes re the legal liability situation
- 06/101 Litter picking – Council warden job – Agenda item 10
- 06/105 Parking on the Commons – posts now erected. Clerk did not hear anything from residents during the installation or since. NFA
- 06/106 Rospa Playground Recommendations - the Clerk assessed the situation in the playground and the mole activity under the equipment appears to have decreased. Clerk has also spoken to Jane Bowden, head of Countryside Services, and she is thinking about a solution.
Clerk has been in touch with Zurich Insurance, which is widely used by other PCs, and is completing forms for an insurance quote as Zurich do their own playground checks.

112. Bus Shelter on Wonersh Common Rd – the bus shelter has now been completed. NFA
- 06/139 Wooden posts along Wonersh Common Rd – the posts have been installed and are just awaiting reflectors. Unfortunately, although they were concreted in, one has already been removed and has to be replaced.
- 06/142 Cleaner Neighbourhood Act - the Cluster meeting has been postponed until 17th April. Clerk has contact number of someone who is trained to carry out some of the obligations under this act.
- 07/011 – Lowering of speed limit in The Street, Wonersh – Clerk has not received a reply or, indeed, even an acknowledgement of her letter from Highways.
- 07/012 Annual Assembly – Clerk has spoken to Alison Harding who can no longer speak on behalf of the SG Parish Plan Committee but she is trying to find someone else. 2 members of the Wonersh Committee, who are not councillors, will speak.
The newsletter is printed and is being circulated to each household with the Village Design Statement. it would be helpful to know of any specific organisations in each village to which newsletters should be sent.
Blackheath Hall is booked.

- 07/024 Volunteer Liaison officer – Following the decision at the last PC meeting, the Clerk has now written to Paul Naphine of Surrey Community Action expressing the Council's regret but declining this project.
- 07/027 Felling of tree on Wonersh playground – tree surgeon has suggested a prunus to replace felled tree.
- 07/029 Schedule for repair of potholes in the parish – the Clerk asked councillors for repair issues but the community gang appeared to arrive in our area the week before they were due so the Clerk is not sure how much of the requested work was carried out. The Clerk will now have to send information re maintenance issues as each councillor informs her instead of collating them as there is no means of knowing when the gang is due to come. The Clerk is also finding it difficult to monitor whether the repairs are being carried out.
