08/174	<b>Bye-Laws</b> Replacement By-law signs ordered from Fastsigns on 13 <sup>th</sup> December 2009
09/102	<b>Bridleway at Lords Hill</b> Mr Assadi has replied to the Clerk's request for SCC to install a sign to ban heavy traffic at the top of Norley Lane, advising that SCC had adopted a policy of de-cluttering and would not introduce a sign as it would lose its impact. The Clerk has written to Cllr Povey, expressing the Council's unhappiness at this response. It appears that a reply has not been received from Dr Povey. Councillors need to decide if this matter is worth pursuing.
