135. Wonersh to Shamley Green footpath – this is being tackled under the Shamley Green Parish Action Plan
- 06/85 Lease at Lordshill Playground – Clerk has responded to Roger Taylor, solicitor. – on-going.
- 06/106 Rospa Playground Recommendations - Maria Cook, the new inspector is inspecting the playgrounds on 17th July and the Clerk hopes to be present.
- 06/142 Cleaner Neighbourhood Act - at the PC meeting on 14.06.07, it was decided NFA.
- 07/011 Lowering of speed limit in The Street, Wonersh – Clerk to discuss with Dr Povey at their meeting on 12.07.07
- 07/016 Correspondence – Hedge at Lordshill playground -the Clerk reported a letter from Jane Bowden dated 26.11.06 agreeing that WBC would cut the hedge and SCC would pay for it. As of July 2007, only some of the hedge has been cut.
- 07/027 Felling of tree on Wonersh playground – Risk Assessment Committee has looked at the playground and the surrounding trees appear to have filled the gap left by the felled tree. They feel another tree planted there would be superfluous. Suggest NFA.
