### Matters Arising Update for Wonersh Parish Council Meeting on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2007

135. Wonersh to Shamley Green footpath – this is being tackled under the Shamley Green Parish Action Plan
- 06/85 Lease at Lordshill Playground – Clerk has forwarded the draft lease to Roger Taylor, solicitor for his opinion. He has replied and asked further questions – on-going
- 06/106 Rospa Playground Recommendations - in conjunction with the Risk Assessment Committee, the Clerk has appointed a new inspector, Maria to carry out the annual playground safety reports. She comes well recommended and is approved by She will provide photos of equipment that needs correction and a clear report of the nature of the problem. She will notify the Clerk when the checks are taking place and, if possible, the Clerk will try to be present.
- 06/142 Cleaner Neighbourhood Act - At the recent Waverley Town and Parish Council meeting, the cluster Clerk group asked Waverley to explain what policies and procedures it was putting in place to enforce the Cleaner Neighbourhoods Act and whether there are any models of Parish Councils working with the Borough Council in Waverley. This was discussed in conjunction with a presentation on the Waverley Clean Up project and it appears the Act confers powers rather than obligation so is not currently being practised as such in Waverley. There is no record of a Parish Council taking on these powers in Waverley.
- 07/011 Lowering of speed limit in The Street, Wonersh – Clerk wrote to Mr Simon Hall of Highways on 7<sup>th</sup> March, e-mailed attaching previous letter on 24<sup>th</sup> April, rang on 23<sup>rd</sup> May and eventually spoke to Mr Hall on 5<sup>th</sup> June. Mr Hall asked Clerk to e-mail him again asking what the procedure is for reducing the speed limit in The Street. Clerk did so within 5 minutes – so far, no response.
- 07/027 Felling of tree on Wonersh playground – Risk Assessment Committee considering replacement tree
- 07/030 Fly tipping in Norley Lane, Shamley Green – NFA until persons who tipped rubbish identified.
- 07/050 Signage at Gerald's Wood - still awaiting repainting
- 07/064 Clerk's Position – Agenda Item 11
- 07/065 Council Warden's Job – Clerk has met with Paul Stephens, the contract has been completed and he started work week beginning 21.05.07. NFA.
