69. Millenium Clock,Blackheath – still pending
135. Wonersh to Shamley Green footpath – this is being tackled under the Shamley Green Parish Action Plan
- 06/85 Lease at Lordshill Playground – Clerk has forwarded the draft lease to Roger Taylor, solicitor for his opinion.
- 06/106 Rospa Playground Recommendations - the Clerk is awaiting a response from Zurich regarding a quote for the Parish Council insurance as they carry out their own playground checks.
- 06/139 Wooden posts along Wonersh Common Rd – the posts have been completed. NFA
- 06/142 Cleaner Neighbourhood Act - Clerk has discussed this item with Clerks in the Cluster group and has received information from a person called Victor Quayle who has qualified to enforce the Cleaner Neighbourhood Act. He is willing to act as a consultant to any Parish Council that wishes to consider taking on any responsibilities under this Act.
- 07/011 – Lowering of speed limit in The Street, Wonersh – Clerk has e-mailed Mr Simon Hall of Highways attaching her previous letter. Still no response.
- 07/027 Felling of tree on Wonersh playground – Risk Assessment Committee to consider this matter at their meeting in July.
- 07/030 Fly tipping in Norley Lane, Shamley Green – Clerk has spoken to the owner of the land who is willing to remove the rubbish himself but said he had been quoted £150 to dump the rubbish and he cannot pay this. Clerk has been in touch with Land Waste Services who run the refuse tip at Slyfield Green and they will not accept fly-tipped rubbish. Clerk has contacted Michael Band and asked if he can liaise with Mr Skinner

The shelter on the Red Lion side is more of a problem as it needs a great deal of work. Mr Cannon has asked if the PC might contribute to costs. The Clerk has replied that each request for funding would be put to the PC and decided on its merits. He is costing repairs
