10/076	<b>Wonersh Parish website</b> Clerk and Cllr Grant to work together to secure new software to permit real-time updates to the Council's website by the Clerk and Members.
10/169(f)	<b>Replacement of the notice board at Blackheath</b> Clerk to liaise with the Chairman of Blackheath Village Hall Committee about the installation of the proposed new community notice board.
10/193	<b>Council Emergency Plans</b> Working Party members to agree on a meeting date to take forward completion of plans for each of the three settlements in the parish.
11/085	<b>Section 9 land</b> Council to approve an application and associated fees to register its interest with HM Land Registry about a parcel of land on Wonersh Common at its meeting in January 2012.
11/106	<b>Provision of amenities for older children in the parish</b> The Chair has agreed to meet parents and older children on 19 November at 2.00pm at the Wonersh playground.
11/121	<b>Surrey Highways - repair to speed limit signage</b> Clerk has requested that Surrey Highways reinstate 30 mph repeater between Wonersh and Bramley.
11/123	<b>Fly-tipping on Council-owned common land</b> Ditch clearance work on Wonersh Common and in front of Lawnsmead completed October 2011. Clerk to write to property owners bordering on Wonersh Common about the importance of keeping ditches clear of garden or other waste for the future.
11/157	<b>HM The Queen's Diamond Jubilee.</b> Cllr R Bawden has received advice from Fields in Trust about eligibility to register the Wonersh Common Sports Field if not already officially designated a War Memorial. The Clerk is checking the records about the conveyance of ownership to WPC from Hambledon District Council to see if there was a reference made to its special status then.
