Matters Arising Update for Wonersh Parish Council Meeting on Thursday 11th October 2007

- 06/85 Lease at Lordshill Playground – The lease as amended by the Parish Council has been sent back to WBC for consideration
- 07/011 Lowering of speed limit in The Street, Wonersh – this matter needs further discussion following the report from the recently formed Traffic Committee of Wonersh residents. The Clerk understands that they will be reporting soon.
- 07/030 Fly tipping in Norley Lane, Shamley Green – this item has been referred to the Waverley Borough Council Clean Up project. Nothing heard yet from WBC regarding this matter.
- 07/050 Signage at Gerald's Wood - still awaiting repainting but in abeyance until the future of the mountain bike track and the use of Gerald's Wood is decided.
- 07/109 Conservation Areas – Clerk has received a reply from Geraldine Moloney, WBC Planning Dept, saying that she will discuss the matter of reviewing Wonersh parish with senior colleagues
- 07/113 Parish Plan – representatives from the 3 village committees have met in order to incorporate the findings and action plans in to one document. See Agenda Item 15(b)
- 07/114 Reports from Working Parties
(c) Shamley Green Shop – Cllr Band has informed the Clerk that he has decided it is not appropriate for him to take this matter up with Ann Bott, WBC Monitoring Officer.

(b) Shamley Green Pond – Cllr Shareef has informed the Clerk that he has been unable to contact the contractor who was gave an estimate for pipe work at the pond.
The Clerk has informed Cllr Band of the activities in which Sarah Henderson is involved of which the Clerk is aware.

Clerk has written to Highways asking why the village gateway at Wonersh has not been re-instated.

the Council were advised that bids have to be made to the Local Committee in Sept but, as there has not been a PC meeting where this could be discussed between the meeting and the deadline for bids, it was discussed between the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Cllr Morris. A decision was made that a bid of some sort should be made in order to maintain the parish profile. In the time, it was not possible to gather information to make a well thought out bid for lowering the speed limit in The Street and changing the junction at The Pepperpot as discussed in council meetings. However, over the years, the extension of the pavement beyond Gerald's Wood has been discussed and requested with SCC. It has been possible to put together a bid for this and the report was circulated to councillors for their comments prior to sending to Dr Povey.
The proposal regarding the continuation of the pavement from The Street in Wonersh to link with Gerald's Wood has been forwarded to Andrew Povey and it has now been sent to the next level.
- 07/146 Allotments – Increase of Rent
Mr Hichens has requested an increase from £250 to £300 per annum. The Council agreed that the clerk should write to Mr Hichens accepting the increase on the condition that the £300 stayed fixed for the next 3 years. The clerk has written and is awaiting a response.
- 07/147 Community Partnership Group
Clerk has investigated the possibility of a rolling representative and this would be fine. No-one attended meeting on the 26th September, however the clerk has requested the minutes. The meetings are to be held quarterly and each meeting is not expected to last longer than 2 hours.
- 07/148 Litter Collection from the Parish – clerk has e-mailed Paul Redmond to request final confirmation of exactly how many litter bins they are planning to remove from their collection route. Clerk has obtained definite costings from Veolia regarding collection of waste and is awaiting quotations on 90 litre rustic bins from Simple Solutions.
- 07/149 Report from Risk assessment Committee - Gerald's Wood
Clerk has spoken with SCAPTC to seek advice. Spoken with Bramley Parish Council re usage of Gerald's Wood and gained a quote for possible fencing options. Clerk will report back under Agenda item 10.

- 07/150 Co-option of new Councillor for Wonersh ward
Clerk has re-advertised the position on all notice boards giving a deadline of the 4 October. No further applicants have come forward.
