11/123	<b>Fly-tipping on Council-owned common land</b> Ditch clearance work on Wonersh Common completed. Ditch clearance in front of Lawnsmead to be completed in early November 2011. Clerk to write to property owners bordering on Wonersh Common about the importance of keeping ditches clear of garden or other waste for the future.
