10/076	Wonersh Parish website Clerk has not so far had time to arrange the purchase of new website software for updating material on the individual pages.
10/103	Drainage across Wonersh Common Memorial Playing Field Cllr Bawden to report on meeting held on 25 August.
10/169(f)	Replacement of the notice board at Blackheath Clerk to liaise with the Chairman of Blackheath Village Hall Committee about the installation of the proposed new community notice board.
10/193	Council Emergency Plans Working Party members to agree on a meeting date to take forward completion of plans for each of the three settlements in the parish.
11/032 11/124(f)	Wonersh burial ground Chair and Clerk to meet the Vicar of Wonersh on 15 September 2011. Wonersh Parochial Church Council has met the costs of recent repairs to the wall. Mr David Wright has been in contact with the Clerk to confirm that he acts as the representative of the owners of Wonersh House and is willing to meet representatives of the PC and PCC to discuss further remedial work to protect the integrity of the boundary wall. PCC to submit estimates for "decent maintenance" of burial grounds to the Clerk for consideration within the budget preparation for 2012/13.
